The PMI Sustainability Community of Practice continues to grow stronger and we are currently building an exciting 2024 agenda of events. We are excited to spotlight an initiative spearheaded by PMI Europe - Climate Fresk.

Climate Fresk is a collaborative workshop aimed at raising awareness of the climate crisis. This fun, interactive workshop takes place over 3 hours, discovering the cause and effects of climate change, and actively engages participants to explore future actions. It is based on the most respected scientific publications: the IPCC reports, which also inform global political and economic decision-making. To date, over 1 million people have participated in Fresks globally.

Following two very successful pilot workshops in 2023 across 9 PMI European Chapters, it was agreed to launch the initiative across Europe. The feedback received was overwhelmingly positive, with an average review of 9.8 out of 10, and highlighting benefits such as bridging climate-knowledge gaps among our members, and making complex information simple.
